

Virtual Fracture Clinic Review service

Following attendance with a fracture (broken bone)



1. Your injury has been assessed and treated by Emergency Department staff (A&E)
2. Your injury and X-rays will be reviewed later by an Orthopaedic Consultant (a doctor who specialises in fractures).
3. Many injuries heal well over time without any further treatment. However, if felt necessary, an appointment will be arranged for you.
4. You will be contacted by a Nurse from the fracture clinic service, by phone, within the next few days to confirm a plan of management and provide further information/advice – even if no follow up is thought to be required.
5. **Please make sure you have given an up to date contact number** to the Emergency dept staff so you can be contacted. The telephone number may show on your caller ID as a 0800 number or it might be the mobile number listed on this leaflet (07779 422980).
